To provide youth soccer goalkeepers, through our commitment to excellence, the opportunities to develop his/her individual technical goalkeeping skills, inspiring them to reach their fullest potential by placing them in a high tempo, small-group training environment, which is challenging, yet still an enjoyable and positive experience which promotes primarily the growth of the player and his/her individual technical goalkeeping skills. This will be done by coinciding the GK:1 Training sessions with Alaska Rush's Saturday Morning Shooting sessions in order to give the goalkeepers a more realistic training environment.

COST – Annual Membership and Monthly Fee:

Training Membership: \$75 annual fee per player

GK:1 Training Monthly Fee: \$50 (4 training sessions per month)
